About the Hospital and Community

Advocate BroMenn Medical Center is a faith-based hospital located in Normal, Illinois, that is a part of the Advocate Health Care system and is one of the most advanced acute care hospitals in central Illinois. This 224-bed facility is a Level II trauma center, featuring emergency services, neurosciences, obstetrics, outpatient surgery and the complete continuum of cardiac care and lab and diagnostic services. Advocate BroMenn is the area leader in nearly all health care services. Bloomington-Normal, Illinois, home to Illinois State University and Illinois Wesleyan University, is a “twin city” community with a population of more than 129,000 that boasts opportunities for cultural and educational experiences.

Upcoming CPE Programs at BroMenn

Congregation-Based Internship

This twelve-week program is primarily geared toward pastors and other ministers in full-time work in a congregation or other setting. Educational sessions are conducted at Advocate BroMenn on Monday mornings and Tuesday afternoons. Students divide their clinical time between pastoral care in their home settings and taking call at the hospital one night per week. Interns receive one unit of CPE for this program and tuition is \$425.

February 2, 2015 – April 21, 2015*

Hospital-Based Internship

This eleven-week program is primarily designed for seminarians and other qualified students who seek to complete a unit of CPE during their summer. This is a full-time, hospital-based experience. Interns receive one unit of CPE for this program and tuition is \$425.

June 2, 2014 – August 15, 2014*

Residency

This full-year stipended program is designed for the individual seeking education for professional chaplaincy. This program provides in-depth study of pastoral care theory and skills. The residency is intended to prepare the student to become certified as a chaplain and can lead to other professional certifications. Residents usually have previously taken a unit of CPE. Residents complete four units of CPE during the program. The stipend for 2014-2015 is \$27,500; Fees: \$125/quarter.
