Job Description:

The Chaplain provides non-denominational pastoral and spiritual care services to older adult residents and their families.

Education and Qualifications:

B.A. from an accredited college or university. M.Div. from an accredited graduate school of theology or seminary is a plus.

Minimum 3-5 years of experience as a Chaplain working with older adults and those who have dementia preferred.

Responsibilities include:

- Providing ecumenical Sunday worship services to residents.
- Presiding over weekly prayer service.
- Presiding over special services including Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Easter, and Christmas (Eve).
- Scheduling and leading memorial services for residents as needed, as well as a biannual community memorial service.
- Running a weekly Bible Study for residents.
- Meeting for one-on-one discussions with residents regarding spirituality, grief and loss, and other topics.
