1. Maintain a relationship with Jesus Christ
 - a. Spend time in God's Word and prayer
2. Provide leadership for our youth program (currently elementary through junior high)
 - a. Direct them to a relationship with Christ
 - b. Encourage them to attend Sunday services and contribute to church
 - c. Encourage them to get their friends involved with the youth group
 - d. Work with the Christian education director to provide Sunday school and children's church activities
3. Plan and organize events for them
 - a. Local events that encourage fun, fellowship, and outreach
 - b. Mission trips that emphasize serving both their community and outside their community
 - c. Regional and national youth events that build and encourage their faith
4. Evangelism and outreach into the community
 - a. Increase the number of people attending the Sunday and Wednesday night groups
 - b. Encouraging spiritual growth through new belief, baptism, discipleship programs

The salary for the position will be 20,000 to 24,000 with 2 weeks' vacation included. Hours in the office will be determined by the youth director. While the focus of the youth director should be on the elementary through junior high ages it is our desire to grow the group to include the college and high school range. When this happens the role of the youth director will be to develop a group of volunteers to teach some of the classes as it is impossible for them to lead every group. The ability to fill in the pulpit once every quarter will also be encouraged.

After 6 months the ministry board will review these expectations and make adjustments as necessary.
