PRACTICAL TRAINING COMPONENTS

Preaching: Residents will receive instruction and coaching in both one-on-one and group settings. Residents will have opportunities to preach in Chapelstreet venues as part of our teaching team.

Leadership: Residents will participate in Chapelstreet's ongoing Leadership Development process with other full and part-time staff.

Pastoral Care: Residents will receive instruction and experience in a variety of pastoral care contexts, including hospital and home visits.

Personal Mentoring & Coaching: We provide residents with strengths-based coaching and mentoring in spiritual formation.

Seminary/Academic Study: While not required for every resident, Chapelstreet will work with each resident to develop a plan for Seminary/Academic Study and a tuition sharing plan.

TIME OFF & COMPENSATION

Residents will receive 2 weeks of vacation per year (with approval of Leadership Development Team). Residents will work an average of 27 hours per week and be compensated with a salary as a part-time employee. More specifics will be discussed on a case by case situation during the interview process.

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We believe that the church has both an opportunity and responsibility to find, equip, and send the next generation of leaders into gospel ministry. Our Pastoral Residency Program is a two-year curriculum of learning, mentoring, and ministry experience.

The Chapelstreet Church Residency Program is specifically designed for potential campus pastor candidates. Each Resident is given a wide-range of opportunities and experiences necessary to prepare him for pastoral leadership.
