The Worship and Family Ministries Director will focus predominantly on Central's Downtown campus to lead worship gatherings, cultivate worship practices throughout the week, lead the Downtown Youth Ministry, and assist other family ministry teams.

Ministry staff receive up to four weeks of vacation per calendar year and are eligible for sabbatical leave after six years of service.
