Reasonable accommodations will be reviewed and approved only for students who have filed the appropriate paperwork and documentation. To be consider for accommodations, complete the Self-identification Accommodation service Request Form and return to Linda Owens.

Disability Policy

It is Northern Seminary, policy to apply enrollment and academic practices without regard to race, color, gender, national or ethnic origin, age, veteran status, or disability. The persons responsible for complying with and carrying out the seminary's responsibilities under this policy in general matters are the Academic Dean and Senior Executive Director of Student Services of the Seminary. It is the seminary's intent to welcome people with disabilities into the school's communal life and mission. Therefore, seminary policy is to ensure that no qualified student with a disability is denied the benefits of, excluded from participation in, or otherwise subjected to discrimination in any seminary program or activity. In response to a request made by a qualified student with a documented disability, the seminary will provide reasonable accommodation and academic adjustments necessary to afford the student the opportunity for full participation in seminary programs. Students should report their academic needs to the Registrar who will communicate with faculty members regarding accommodations to be made. Students should report their general needs to the office of the Student Services.
