PASTORAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Preaching/Teaching

- Be willing to teach in small group settings

Additional services - weddings, baptisms, funerals, child dedications, etc.

Leadership

- Work with leaders to discern God's vision for the church
- Inspire and instruct people to participate in that vision
- Enlist, train, mentor, and guide believers for the work of Christ

Relational/shepherding

- Developing authentic relationships with the attenders at JBF
- Organizing visits to those who are ill, in need, new to the church, etc.
- Biblical counseling

Outreach - lead JBF to reach the lost and unchurched for Christ whether locally or to far nations

Administrative duties

- Be involved in the business aspects of church
- Organize, attend and/or facilitate meetings, events, and brainstorming sessions
- Delegate or direct staff and volunteers to accomplish task

Respectful responsiveness - timely, kind, and accurate responses both verbally and via email/text
