Outreach Community Ministries, Inc. (OCM) is a Christian, community service organization seeking to attract and hire a diverse staff of highly competent professional employees.

Position Title: Part-time Crisis Intervention Team Member

Division: Wheaton Youth Outreach (WYO)

Wheaton Youth Outreach is a community-based youth and family resource center serving the greater Wheaton area. Services include counseling for individuals, couples and families, crisis intervention for runaway and homeless teens, casework services for basic needs, and transitional housing for young women.

Job Responsibilities: The Crisis Intervention Team Member serves on WYO's Specialized Youth Services Team, providing support to youth in crisis to keep youth safe, connected to their parents and prevent or minimize involvement with child welfare and juvenile justice systems. Responsibilities include providing crisis intervention services to local police departments regarding runaway or locked-out youth and competing case and grant-related documentation.

Requirements: Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Social Work, Counseling, or a related field; previous experience with youth; ability to navigate the legal and mental health delivery systems; sensitivity to the needs of low-income and culturally diverse populations. Valid IL driver's license, insurance, reliable vehicle and good driving record. Must live within 30 minutes of downtown Wheaton to respond to crisis calls. Microsoft Word/Excel experience. A commitment to Outreach Community Ministries' Statement of Mission and Faith. Bilingual (Spanish/English) a plus.

Status: Part-time. Availability to carry the pager and respond to crisis calls on a rotating, on-call basis. Scheduled to be on-call one week at a time out of every month outside of regular business hours. Schedule to include Monday – Friday from 5:00pm – 8:30am and for 24 hours on Saturday, Sunday, and Agency Holidays.

Compensation: During training: \$50 per week to carry the pager and \$50 per hour for the first two hours of crisis intervention and \$25 for each additional hour. Once training is complete: \$100 per week to carry the pager (\$125 for weeks with an agency recognized holiday) and \$100 per hour for the first two hours of crisis intervention, and \$50 per hour for each additional hour. Additional reimbursement available for travel related expenses when responding to crisis calls.
